77 year old female. Multi year history of neuropathy of unknown cause. History of left hallux and 2nd toe amputations. Patient presents on 3-28-11 with an ulcer to her right 5th toe with exposed bone. Medicore CuTEC[™] dressing applied this date. Ulcer is well healed on 5-3-11.



Patient # 1854

67 year old male. Multi year history of diabetes, hypertension, cardiovascular disease, and peripheral neuropathy. Left 5th MPJ ulcer present on 3-15-11. Measures 2.8 x 1.2 cm. Medicore CuTEC[™] dressing applied this date. Ulcer closed on 4-11-11.













Patient # 13363

70 year old female. Twelve year history of diabetes, hypertension, and cardiovascular disease. Patient presents on 2-14-11 after hospitalization for cellulitis and ulceration on right foot. Medicore CuTEC[™] dressing applied this date. Ulcer shows improvement 6-9-11.





Patient # 5730

53 year old male. Eighteen year history of diabetes, hypertension, cardiovascular disease, kidney disease, and R hallux amputation. Patient presents on 3-29-11 relating that he hit his right 3rd toe on a door leading to loss of that nail. Medicore CuTEC[™] dressing applied to infected area. Toe is well healed on 4-4-11.











Patient # 5730

37 year old male, diabetic, kidney disease, HIV positive, hypertensive, cardiovascular disease, and history of stroke. History of right 4th and 5th toe amputation in 2004. Second toe left foot amputated in 2008. Patient presents 3-24-11 c/o a 3 month history of ulceration to the left 1st and 5th MPJ region. First MPJ ulcer measures 1.0 x 1.5 cm this date, the 5th MPJ plantar ulceration measures 1.1 x 0.4 cm, and the 5th MPJ dorsal ulcer measures 1.0 $x 1.0 \times 0.5$ cm with significant drainage and ability to probe to bone. Medicore CuTEC[™] dressing was applied to all areas. Most recent visit on 5-25-11 shows the 1st MPJ ulceration measures 10.0 x 8.0 mm, the plantar 5th MPJ ulcer measures 5.0 x 2.0 mm, and the dorsal 5th MPJ ulcer measures 2.0 x 2.0 mm.

Ulcer measures 5.0 x 2.0 mms. Medicore CuTECTM dressing applied to ulcerative area. Ulcer is well healed on 3-16-11.







Patient # 9671

42 year old male. Twenty-two year history of paraplegia, along with multi year history of psoriasis. Patient smokes 1/2 pack per day. Three year history of left leg ulceration. Left leg ulceration measured 2.1 x 1.5cm on 2-23-11. First application of Medicore CuTEC[™] dressing this date. Lesion completely closed on 5-23-11.







Patient # 14408
